The Housing Authority of the City of Antigo is seeking a progressive leader to fill the position of Executive Director for the Antigo Housing Authority. The Executive Director implements both long term vision and short term operational priorities and is responsible for overall agency performance.

The successful candidate will lead and manage the agency with an annual operating budget of 2.5 million, a portfolio that includes 149 Section 8 Housing Choice Vouchers and 282 units of affordable housing with mixed financing including Rental Assistance Demonstration Program, Low Income Housing Tax Credits, HUD multifamily housing, and WHEDA & USDA Rural Development income restricted housing. This position leads and supports a highly experienced long-serving staff and reports to a five-member Board of Commissioners.

The ideal candidate must demonstrate excellent leadership skills, thorough knowledge of HUD and USDA Rural Development programs; ability to communicate effectively with individuals from a broad range of socio-economic and cultural backgrounds.

Position requires minimum five years of progressively responsible housing experience in program administration and management, and at least two years of supervisory experience in this capacity; bachelor's degree in business, finance or related field OR substantial experience and proven track record in related field will be considered as an alternative to degree.
