

DEPUTY DIRECTOR

The Housing Authority of Racine County (HARC), located in Racine, Wisconsin, is in search of a dynamic leader to serve as Deputy Director. HARC provides housing assistance for over 1700 income qualified individuals throughout Racine County. Located on Lake Michigan, HARC is a consistently “high performing” Housing Authority in a beautiful part of the Midwest.

The successful candidate will manage a housing portfolio that includes approximately 1710 units of Housing Choice Vouchers, including a Family Self-Sufficiency program, VASH, Foster Youth Initiative, and Mainstream Vouchers, as well as multifamily properties owned by HARC.

HARC is seeking to expand its operations by way of development, program opportunities, and grants for projects that support our mission. A proven track record of successful personnel management, strategic and organizational planning, and working with housing programs is required. Must have proven leadership ability working with staff, government officials, community service organizations, and residents.

HARC is looking for someone with working knowledge of Federally funded programs, tax credit programs, and WHEDA. Experience in related industries will be considered. Must have experience with grant writing and grant administration. Proficiency with technology, and experience with budgeting and financial reporting is required.

A Bachelors’ degree in Public Administration or a closely related field, and five or more years’ experience working with federal housing programs is required, preferably in a management capacity.
